1. Welcome and Apologies

JR welcomes all and introductions made.

2. Minutes of the Last Meeting

The minutes of the last meeting were approved.

3. Chair – news and current issues

First SAFAP meeting for JR, who introduces herself and also welcomes KR.

4. TTU Report

- **Heritage Crime**

Update on Dunadd Fort illegal detecting sentencing. Panel thanks colleagues at HES and other organisations for hard work on the case and other on-going heritage crime related cases. KR (HES rep) notes the significant time and resources this case required from HES and other organisations. EF updates panel on TTU involvement with the Scottish Heritage Crime Group (SHCG) and recent attendance at the Royal Highland Show where the new Scottish Partnership Against Rural Crime (SPARC) strategy was launched. Heritage Crime group continue to work on a heritage crime specific strategy for Scotland.

- **TTU processes**

An audit of finds was carried out by TTU from 2021-2022 which helped to quantify the pandemic-created backlog. This was instrumental in presenting a case to QLTR and SG for a number of temporary fixed term TTU Officer posts to aid in tackling the backlog. TTU and NMS successful in securing 3 x temporary TTU Officers (18 month contracts). Applications have now closed and recruitment is ongoing. Recruitment for vacant permanent TTU Officer role carried out at the same time.

TTU are working on methodology for new staff induction and training. TTU notes that the new staff will be much appreciated.

- **Future caselists**

TTU have 4 caselists drafted and continue to identify potential claim cases as new finds are processed. EF reminds panel that individual cases vary in their workload and can contain anything from a single artefact to thousands. JR reiterates that case numbers don't directly reflect workload.

- **Outreach**

TTU have undertaken a number of outreach events throughout late 2021 and 2022, including trips to Elgin Museum, Aberdeen and Kirkcudbright. Up-coming outreach planned with Scottish Detector Club and Scottish Artefact Recovery Group. Online outreach conducted with a number of U3A groups and with Kelso High School as part of an inter-generational project with Archaeology Scotland. Further online talks planned. EF refers to recent SHCG and TTU presence at Royal Highland Show being a good opportunity for public visibility, and notes that landowners and farmers could be a target group for future outreach.

- **Peebles Hoard update**

The Peebles hoard, which was first discovered in the summer of 2020, has now been fully excavated in lab conditions at NMCC. This followed a second CT scan by the University of Southampton, with excavation work undertaken by Dr Matt Knight and Mary Davis (NMS), supported by TTU. The hoard is extremely significant, with many of the items from it having no parallel in the archaeological record. TTU will continue to work towards processing the case to bring it before a future panel meeting for allocation.

- **Thanks**

NMS, TTU, QLTR and SAFAP would like to thank Ella Paul, who recently left TTU, for her excellent work, and wish her the best in her new role.

- **General updates**

SA commends the opportunity to recruit 3 new temporary staff members at TTU. SA notes that the work on the Peebles Hoard, especially in terms of NMS staff resources, continues to be substantial. NMS are working to outline a procedure for 'extraordinary circumstance' cases, such as Peebles. Agreement that quantifying the work undertaken by all parties in the processing of such a case is beneficial for planning in future. Galloway Hoard exhibition is due to leave Kirkcudbright Galleries soon, before moving to Aberdeen in July 2022.

TTU are working towards reinstating 3 panel meetings per year. TTU and SAFAP to consider appropriate dates for next panel meeting.
